Access will be via the side of the field opposite the Tile Shop at the end of Long Lane. If the crop is still in the field, please walk along the tram lines. Take care on the uneven surface.

STREET PARKING

There is a short walk (along pavements on the opposite side of the road) to the preferred parking places:
Please park on Crees Lane,
Or the layby by the 'North' field (where we test-pitted in 2013)
Or along Brockton Ave (wider and less busy than Long Lane)

Please do not park so as to cause any obstructions or nuisance to residents.

ACCESS

1. Enter field opposite Long Lane and just N of the wire fence around the Severn Trent Water building.
2. Follow the wire fence, then a wooden fence, along the field-edge. At the corner, turn and keep following the wooden fence to where the telegraph posts cross the field.
3. Our 'base' will be in the second garden to the right. To access the garden you will need to cross with great care the low wire-netting (trip hazard) where it will be marked with tape.

4. You can leave your personal items (e.g. lunch, waterproofs) at the base camp, but please keep any valuable items with you.
